

SUMMER IN THE PORCUPINE MOUNTAINS

(OVERNIGHT MOTORCOACH TOUR)

This two day/one night tour takes you from Marquette to the Porcupine Mountains where you will get the chance to celebrate the summer solstice with a beachfront bonfire and see some of the finest attractions in the Porcupine Mountains State Wilderness Park including the Visitor Center, Lake of the Clouds, Summit Peak, Greenstone Falls and the waterfalls at the mouth of the Presque Isle River. Other attractions you will see include Canyon Falls on the Sturgeon River near L'Anse and Bond Falls on the middle branch of the Ontonagon River near Paulding. Your overnight accommodations will be at the waterfront AmericInn Lodge and Suites in Silver City and we will be stopping at the Hardwood Steakhouse in Covington for a Dutch-treat dinner on the return. Your host and guide will be Fred Huffman from Marquette Country Tours and transportation will be provided by Checker Bus.

Tour Dates: The tour will depart on Tuesday, June 20th and return on Wednesday, June 21st.

Tour Cost: \$ 274.00 for single occupancy, \$ 209.00 per person for double occupancy, \$ 187.00 per person for triple occupancy and \$ 181.00 per person for quad occupancy.

The cost is based on a 25 person minimum/40 person maximum and all NCLL and City of Marquette Senior Center members will receive a \$ 10.00 per person discount off the cost listed above.

The cost includes tour planning and booking services, motorcoach transportation, tour guide services, all admissions, a box lunch on the trail and overnight lodging and breakfast at the AmericInn in Silver City.

Departure Time: The tour will depart on Tuesday, June 20th from the eastside parking lot of the Berry Events Center in Marquette at 8:00 am and from the Ishpeming Jubilee parking lot at 8:30 am.

(Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled departure time)

Return Time: The tour will return on Wednesday, June 21st to the Ishpeming Jubilee parking lot at 9:30 p.m. and the eastside parking lot of the Berry Events Center at 10:00 p.m.

Please Note: This tour involves some hiking and is designed for people in relatively good shape that are capable of navigating steps, hilly terrain and forest trails that may be wet, slippery and uneven.

Although we will be on improved trails maintained by the State Wilderness Park not all of the trails are accessible. If you are not sure footed and able to walk at least a mile this tour is probably not for you.
